



## AMT MISSION TRIP – KYRGYZSTAN

### YOUTH CAMP MINISTRY: 16 – 30 July 2026



Participate in a week-long outreach camp to 200 secondary school students in a Muslim context in Bishkek (Kyrgyzstan). Following the camp, participants will fly to Tashkent for a cultural experience to visit ancient historic sites in Uzbekistan. The trip will include cultural orientation, seminars, workshops, evangelistic meetings, music ministries, and helping run youth programs.

**Arrive:** Bishkek (Kyrgyzstan)

**Depart:** Tashkent (Uzbekistan)

**Entry:** Visas not included in trip cost, passport must be valid for 6 months

**Language:** English

**Cost:** AU\$3999 (deposit AU\$500)

Includes: international and domestic flights, travel insurance, accommodation (campsite & hotels), meals, sightseeing, and local transport
