This year again we are producing and distributing the Bible Gems calendar. We have seen an increase of 2,490 calendars this year to meet prison requirements. So far this year, 705 Bible studies have been ordered from the calendar inserts alone, and only eternity will reveal the fruit that has resulted from this gospel outreach. Please continue to pray for the prison ministry as we supply bible study courses to the inmates. Many of our inmate students are held on remand for over two years, waiting for their day in court. Well over 3,000 Bible study courses have been distributed so far this year, and over 2,000 of these recipients are actively completing their studies and engaging with us.
