Matthew 9:38 Prayer Rhythm

As we step into another week of prayer, we're reminded of a simple but powerful challenge shared at the CCCAust Conference: to set an alarm for 9:38 each day and pause to pray through Matthew 9:38 — "Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field."

We'd love to encourage you to join in this rhythm. Set your alarm, take that moment, and ask God to raise up and send workers into His harvest field. Your prayers matter, and together we trust Him to move.

Bill & Sandra Callister, (NSW, DPG Day 3)

Give thanks for Bill and Sandra's safe return to NSW after six weeks of Scripture recording in Alotau. Pray for the Misima team now home, and for the Saisai team still waiting for a boat. Ask God to smooth the processing of all recordings, and to provide someone skilled to help sync the audio with the text while Bill and Sandra complete reporting and financial tasks.

Phil & Fiona Emery, (PNG, DPG Day 8)

Pray for smooth, safe travel as Phil and Fiona fly from Cairns to PNG, with good connections through Port Moresby to Goroka.
