OUTREACH TO PILGRIMS: 22 September – 5 October 2026



Spain is a traditionally Catholic culture with a secular modern society. There is still a big need to church plant in towns and areas where there are no or very few evangelical churches. On this women-only trip, you will visit church-planting missionary families and reach out to pilgrims walking the Camino de Santiago trail. Experience the trail for yourself, serve practically in the Pilgrims Albergue, and help with local church activities.
